The Public Open House will enable community members to review the current progress of the Sudbury Soils Study, as well as share personal input with Study Partners.

The Sudbury Soils Study is a community-wide undertaking to accurately evaluate the levels of nickel, copper, cobalt, and arsenic in the local environment. It is the most comprehensive and scientifically demanding study of its kind ever done in Ontario. Thousands of soil samples have been taken from throughout the region and are being carefully analysed to assess their contents. From these soil assessments the community will learn of any possible risks these elements may pose to human health and/or the health of the environment. Final results are expected by mid-2005.


